The concern about vocational training (VT), school based or not, is increasing around Europe during the last years. But vocational training has some prejudices. Many supporters of VT state, on the contrary, think about VT that could be a kind of positive prejudice. The paper analyses the survey ETEFIL (carried on by INE 2005, about the insertion on the labour market), so the researchers could confirm or no these prejudices, through the construction of learning and labour pathways of young people who has complete a vocational training course .

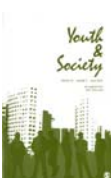

Storen, Liv Anne. Limited Access to Apprenticeships, "State Dependence" or Low Qualifications.

This article studies the transition from school to work among youth with low or medium-low competence level. Youth who have proceeded to higher education are excluded from the analyses. The youth have all participated in Norwegian upper secondary education, but many have not completed their schooling. The situation of youth of non-Western origin and ethnic Norwegian youth is compared. The ethnic minority youth do not have the same probability of being employed as the ethnic majority youth with the same competence and grades level. The positive effect of apprenticeship experience was less important than what was expected.

Ipar Irlandan, integrazio sozio-erlijiosoak eta etnia nahasketak agenda politikoan pisu handia duten arren, bake prozesuak orain arte huts egin du gazte ahulenen beharrei aurre egiteko, adibidez, bere burua gay, lesbiana edo bisexualtat hartzen dutenak. Ipar Irlandako iritzi publikoak sexu bereko erakargarritasuna duten pertsonen kontrako girokoa izaten jarraitzen du. Urteroko Young Life and Times (YLT) inkestaren arabera, ARCAK 16 urtekoen artean egiten duen inkesta, sexu bereko erakargarritasuna sentitzen dutenek esperientzia okerragoak adierazten dituzte hainbat sektoreetan. Besteak beste, hezkuntza sektorean (adibidez: sexu-hezkuntza edo eskola-jazarpena), osasun mental txarragoa pairatzen dute edo Ipar Irlandatik alde egingo dutela berriro ez itzultzeko esateko joera daukate.
