This article uses data from a sample of early adolescents to examine: levels of consumerism; relationships between different aspects of consumerism and well-being; and differences according to gender, school year group and family affluence. Data were obtained in 2010 via secondary school pupil surveys. There was evidence of high penetration of consumerist values. Many relationships between consumerism and well-being were stronger than those between family affluence and well-being. These results suggest only certain aspects of consumerism are associated with poorer adolescent well-being.

Youth subcultures have played an important role in social change since the mid-twentieth century, while adolescence and youth were becoming a separate social group and vital reference stages were being conformed. In this role, media idols have led to the genesis and provision of styles and values that are specific to each subculture; and their totemic function has provided an influence for generations, becoming cultural icons. In the first decade of the twenty-first century, however, idols and tribes have lost gravity and definition, and, consequently, young people, beyond the post-modern neo-tribal logic advocated by Maffesoli, are seeing the said post-modernisation processes with a critical eye.
