Spain already has a National Youth Guarantee Implementation Plan, like other EU member states, as a measure to fight against unemployment through labour integration or through self-employment and entrepreneurship. It features 100 measures and involves social agents and public administrations. It is based on formulas that have already been applied in the past. New features include: the high amount to be invested and the time period during which the administrations are committed to submitting a proposal. The focus is on whether this can change the trend and the consequences of any failure to comply with the commitments entered into

The youth employment initiative is a financial instrument launched by the European institutions with the aim of reducing youth unemployment rates of 25% in member states. The EU institutions do not have direct competences in this field but the Commission is trying to relax the conditions of the labour market and the Parliament has called for the guarantee mechanism even though it is not fully satisfied. The Commissioner of Employment understands that the youth guarantee will be more successful if it comes with supporting macroeconomic instruments. France supports a greater funding of the initiative but Germany has rejected these proposals. The possible solutions to youth unemployment have been weighed down by the lack of any commitment to support the future of young people, their well-being in the years ahead. In Spain, Garantía Joven Aragón and Activación Juvenil in Gijón, among others, have been launched.

The National Youth Guarantee Implementation Plan in Germany strengthens the Role of the Federal Employment Agency and is supported by the local job-centre network. It understands that young people should receive a decent offer in the shape of a package with guidance options that adapts to their specific needs. It insists on the cooperation with state and non-state stakeholders (schools, chambers of commerce, unions, etc.) and between the federal government and the federated states. It promotes early interventions, the prevention of dropping out of school, mobility, support for young people with disabilities or an immigrant background, entrepreneurship... It also establishes funding through taxes, insurance and contributions by businesses.
