

## *Assessment of the course titled "Inclusion of people with functional diversity (disability) in activities, programmes and services for young people"*

### **First course of the 2020 Training Plan of the Basque Youth Observatory has been held in Bilbao**

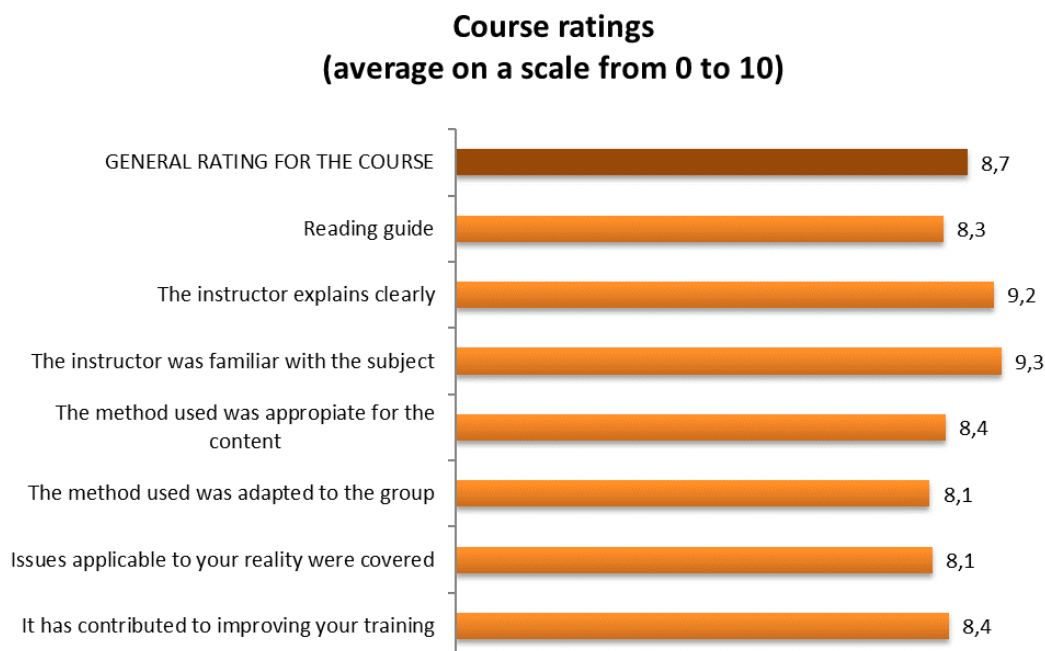
On February 2020 the course titled "***Inclusion of people with functional diversity (disability) in activities, programmes and services for young people***" was held in Bilbao with the aim of training professionals in social intervention, municipal technicians, leisure time monitors and educational staff who have contact with young people and want to have a broad vision of the inclusion of young people with functional diversity in leisure and free time.

The course has been directed by **Ruth San Cristóbal, Itziar Sánchez and Nagore Álvarez.**

**25 people**, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 72 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- Other 12 % were professionals related to education.
- Finally, 16 % were people with other work-profiles.

Every course took a total of 13 hours spread over three sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
