

Assessment of the course titled "*Sex Education: Committed to Quality Relationships*"

The Basque Youth Observatory has organized another course of its training plan

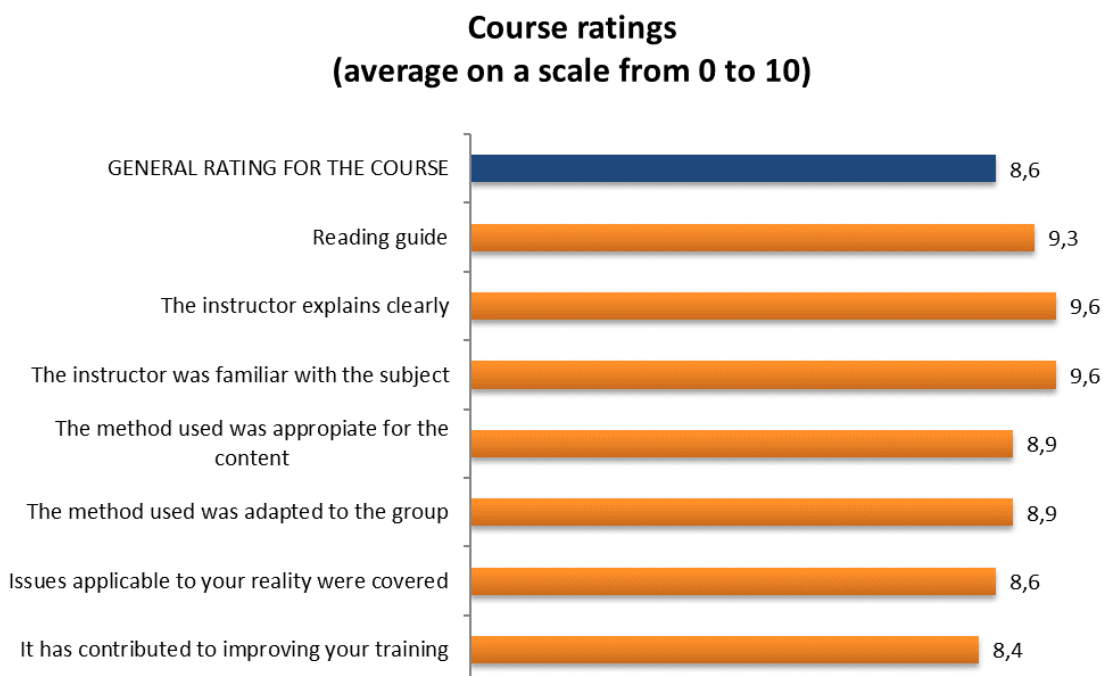
Along October, the Basque Youth Observatory has organized the course "**Sex Education: Committed to Quality Relationships**". The general objective is to contribute to the awareness of educational personnel, from understanding and cultivation of the importance of attention to people's sexuality with which they work, children and youth. This being fundamental to the development. The aim is to promote the integral development of the person, as well as the construction of positive and quality relationships.

The course was given by **Maider García de Vicuña Quintana**, expert in sexology by Incisex and graduate in Psychology.

12 people, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 75 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- Other 17 % were professionals related to education.
- Finally, 8 % were people with other work-profiles.

The course took a total of 15 hours spread over three sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
