

## Assessment of the course titled "*Cybersecurity or the Challenge of Taking Responsibility*"

### **The Basque Youth Observatory has organized another course of its 2021 training plan**

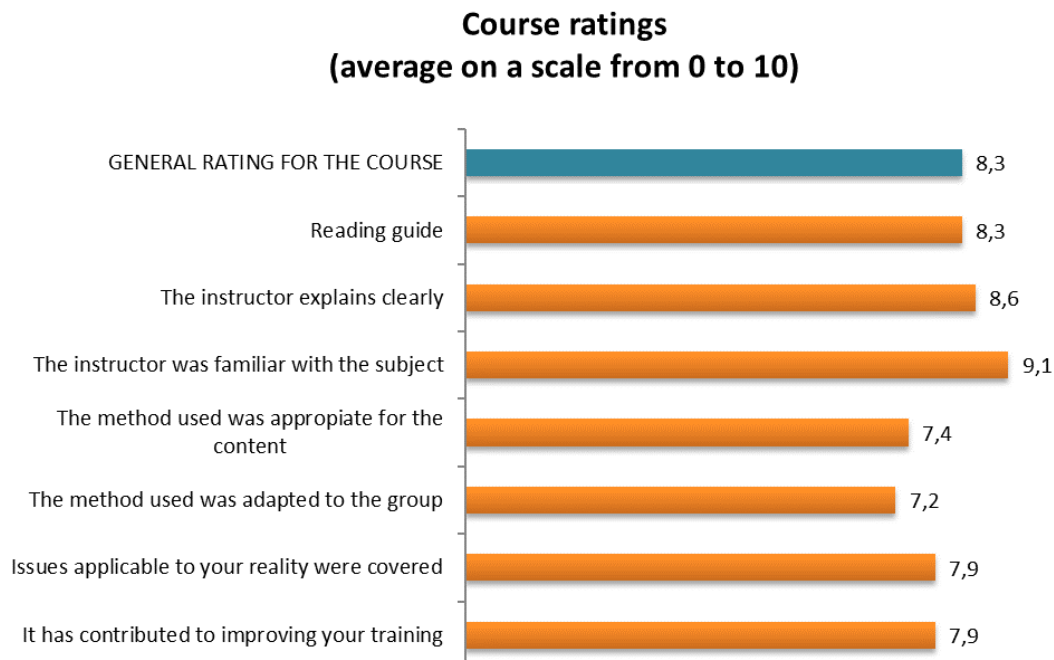
Along May, the Basque Youth Observatory has organized the course "**Cybersecurity or the Challenge of Taking Responsibility**". The main objective of the course was to learn about the main current risks and threats and to reflect on how to deal with them and the fundamental role of the human factor in these risks.

The course was given by **Ane Martínez Recio. Internet and digital tools consultant, expert in training, capacity building and technological coaching at Ezberdin, Digitalde and AiaraValley..**

**10 people**, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 60 % were professionals related to education.
- Other 30 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- Last 10 % were people with other profiles.

The course took a total of 15 hours spread over three sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
