The Basque Youth Observatory has organized the four courses of its 2021 training plan




The course was given by **Eider Goiburu**, social psychologist, sex educator and equality technician.

38 people attended and the training sessions were divided into two working groups:

- ✓ Group A: made up of formal education workers: teachers, guidance counsellors, coeducation officers, education technicians, etc.
- ✓ Group B: made up of non-formal education workers: educators, youth workers, etc.

The courses took a total of 10 hours spread over two sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
