The Basque Youth Observatory has organized two courses of its 2021 training plan


Along February and March, the Basque Youth Observatory has organized the course "Design and management of European youth projects. New features regarding the ERASMUS+YOUTH and EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS Design and management of European youth projects. The general objective of the programme is to find out what is new in the programmes, who can participate and how to participate.


The course was given by Jorge Sáez (Technician of the Eurodesk and Europe Direct centre in Donostia San Sebastián) and Oihane Amoedo (KAEBNAI International Mobility Trainer and former EVS).

37 people, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 55 % were professionals related to education.
- 38 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- 7 % were professionals not related to youth-fields.

The course took a total of 15 hours spread over three sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
