The Basque Youth Observatory has organized the second course of its 2021 training plan

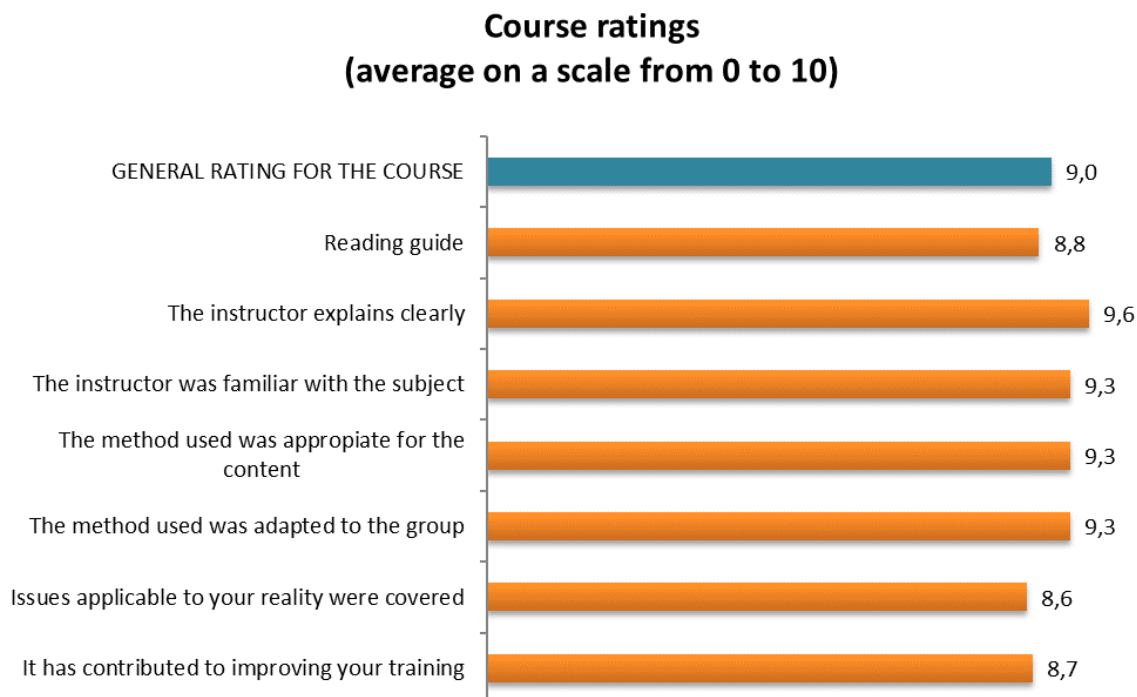
Along February, the Basque Youth Observatory has organized the course "***Fun with Science and Technology***". The overall objective of the programme is to provide a variety of resources on the development of computational thinking and the dissemination and promotion of science and technology that will computational thinking and the dissemination and promotion of science and technology that are suitable for young suitable for groups of young people in non-formal education settings.

The course was given by personnel from **DeustoLearningLab at the School of Engineering of Deusto University**.

11 people, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 64 % were professionals related to education.
- 27 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- 9 % were professionals not related to youth-fields.

The course took a total of 15 hours spread over three sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
