

Assessment of the courses titled "Youth violence: origin, nature, types of violence and strategies for prevention and intervention"

The Basque Youth Observatory has organized the first three courses of its 2022 training plan

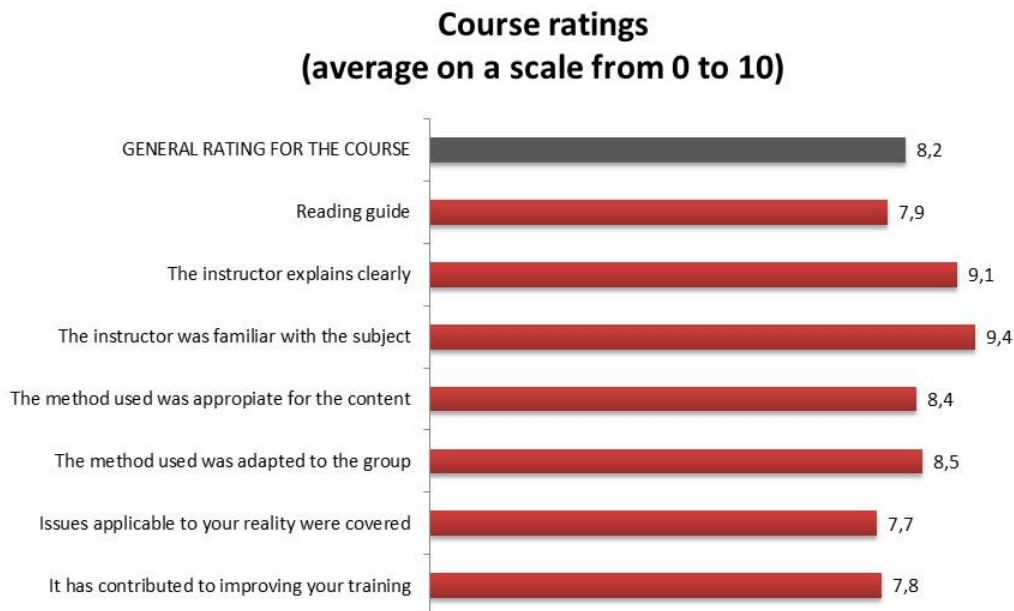
In January and February, the Basque Youth Observatory held the courses "Youth violence: origin, nature, types of violence and prevention and intervention strategies" in Bilbao, Donostia and Vitoria-Gasteiz. The main objective of the course has been to provide a meeting point where staff working with young people have the opportunity to jointly discuss and analyze all aspects related to violent behavior among young people and share experiences.

The course was given by **Hilario Garrudo Hernández**, clinical psychologist, psychotherapist and trainer.

45 people, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 70 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- Other 30 % were professionals related to education.

The course took a total of 10 hours spread over two sessions and the average assessments (on a scale from 0 to 10) provided by attendees were as follow:
