

Evaluation of the courses on "Strategies for the prevention of gender-based violence with young people in formal and non-formal education"

Throughout March and April, the Basque Youth Observatory organised four courses as part of its 2022 training plan

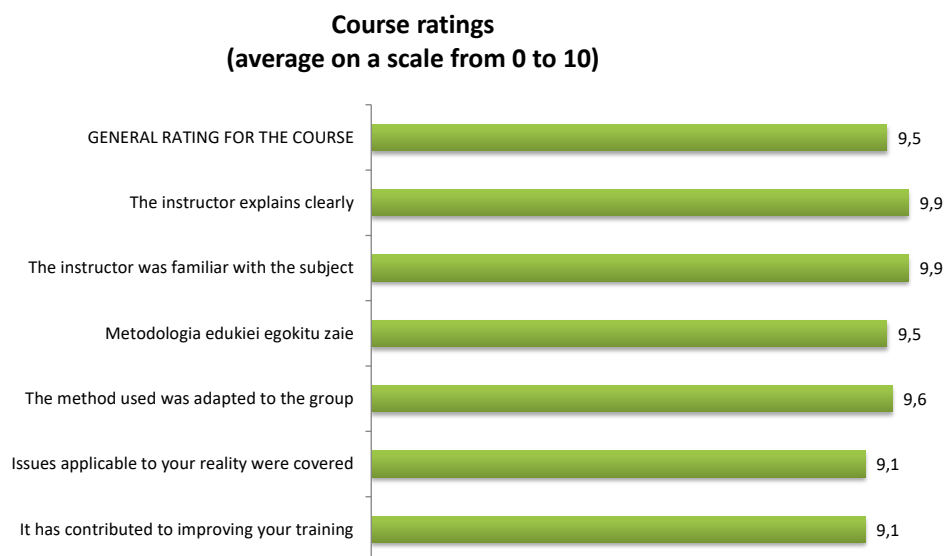
In March and April, the Basque Youth Observatory held four editions of the course "Strategy for the prevention of sexist violence with young people in formal and non-formal education". The main objective of this training has been to offer both technical and political managers of the administration, as well as professionals from public and private entities working in the field of youth, resources for the prevention of sexist violence.

The course was given by **Eider Goiburu**, social psychologist, sex educator and equality technician.

It was attended by **38 people** and the training was divided into two working groups:

- Group A: made up of formal education workers: teachers, guidance counsellors, coeducation officers, education technicians, etc.
- Group B: made up of non-formal education workers: educators, youth workers, etc.

Each of the courses lasted 15 hours, spread over two days, and the average evaluations (on a scale of 0 to 10) of the people who took part in the course were as follows:
