17 people, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 70 % were professionals related to education.
- 12 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
- 18 % were professionals not related to youth-fields.
