

In 2022, 199 professionals took part in the courses organised by the Basque Youth Observatory



The average rating of the courses on a scale from 0 to 10 was 8.8 points

During 2022 the Basque Youth Observatory has organised **8** training courses, both face-to-face and on-line.

Face-to-face courses

- *Youth violence: origin, nature, types of violence and strategies to prevent it and intervene* (**three editions**, Bilbao, Donostia-San Sebastián and Vitoria-Gasteiz)
