

## In 2023, 309 professionals took part in the courses organised by the Basque Youth Observatory



***The average rating of the courses on a scale from 0 to 10 was 8.9 points***

During 2023 the Basque Youth Observatory has organised **8** training courses, both face-to-face and on-line.

### **Face-to-face courses**

- ***Perspective and Educational Tools for Working on Equality and Masculinity with Adolescent Males* (two editions, one in Bilbao and the other in Donostia-San Sebastián)**
- ***Course on the 2030 Agenda and Sustainable Development Goals* (two editions, one in Bilbao and the other in Donostia-San Sebastián)**
- ***Managing Anxiety and Emotional Distress: Tools for Working with Young People* (three editions, one for each historical territory: Bilbao, Donostia-San Sebastián and Vitoria-Gasteiz)**
- ***Conflict Resolution and Negotiation in Socio-Educational Interventions with Young People* (two editions, one in Bilbao and the other in Donostia-San Sebastián)**

- **Strategy for the Prevention of Gender-Based Violence with Young People in Formal Education:**
  - Teachers and guidance counsellors (**two editions**, one in Bilbao and the other in Donostia-San Sebastián)
  - Edition for non-formal education professionals (**an edition** in Bilbao)
- **Digitalization in the Experience of Sexuality** (**an edition** in Bilbao)
- **Pornography and Education: A Comprehensive Approach to a Global Problem** (**two editions**, one in Bilbao and the other in Donostia-San Sebastián)

Of the 309 people who took part in the courses, **242 were women** and **67 were men**. Regarding the **professional profile**, 153 were people working in secondary education, such as guidance counsellors and teachers; another 144 were people working in the youth field (staff from youth information offices, town councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational intervention teams and other entities) and another 12 had other professional profiles.
