

## Assessment of the course titled "New Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps Inclusion and Diversity Strategy 2021-2027 management of European youth projects"

### **The Basque Youth Observatory has organized the first course of its 2023 training plan**

Along January, the Basque Youth Observatory has organized the course "**New Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps Inclusion and Diversity Strategy 2021-2027 management of European youth projects**". The general objective of the course is to make known the novelties of this strategy, its new priorities and actions in which to develop youth mobility projects.

The course was given by **Jorge Sáez** (technician of the Eurodesk and Europe Direct centre in Donostia San Sebastián) and **Ainhoa Martín** (technician of Europe Direct centre in Donostia San Sebastián).

**20 people**, with the following professional profiles, attended:

- 70 % were professionals related to education.
- 30 % of those present worked in youth-related fields (youth information offices, city councils, provincial councils and youth associations, socio-educational staff and other entities).
